

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-123

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 166.041, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2020-121, FINALIZING AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021, BY AMENDING EXHIBIT "A," THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the City Charter and all the laws of the State of Florida, the City Commission of the City of Coral Springs finalized and adopted budgets for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the Debt Service and Health and Liability Fund, as adopted by Ordinance 2020-121 on September 21, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission acknowledges that an additional amendment is required to the Annual Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021, as designated in Exhibit "A;"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Each and all of the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. That the Annual Operating Budget, approved by the City Commission on September 21, 2020, is amended as designated in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

SECTION 3. The City Commission hereby ratifies and confirms all other provisions of Ordinance 2020-121.



SECTION 5. Severability. Should any part, term or provision of this Ordinance be by the courts decided to be invalid, illegal or in conflict with any law of this State, the validity of the remaining portions or provisions shall not be affected thereby.


SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon the approval of the City Commission.
