#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2019-103**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 166.041, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2018-117, FINALIZING AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019, BY AMENDING EXHIBIT "A", THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET AND EXHIBIT "B", THE CAPITAL **IMPROVEMENT** PROGRAM: **PROVIDING CONFLICT**; **SEVERABILITY**; PROVIDING **FOR** PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
